- Identifying the strategic objective

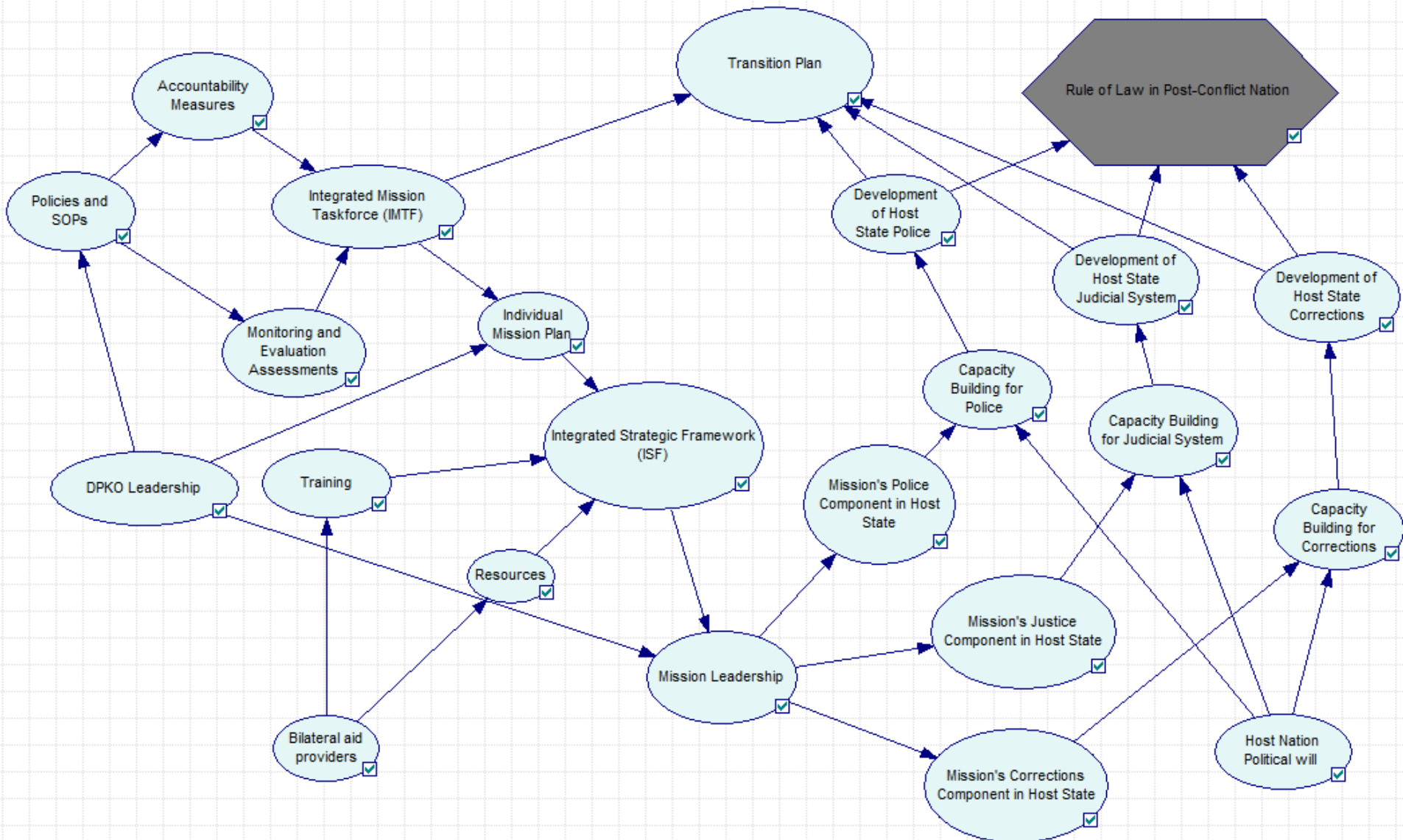
# Expert Elicitation

- Causal versus temporal
- Not having more than three 'parental' nodes
- Three different main components:
  - > Police, Corrections, Justice
