Professor George Peden

University of Stirling

George Peden graduated from the universities of Dundee and Oxford. He taught at the universities of Leeds and Bristol before being appointed to the Chair of History at Stirling in 1990. From 1987 to 1989 he held a British Academy Readership and he has been a visiting fellow at All Souls College, Oxford, from 1988 to 1989 and St Catherine's College, Oxford, in 2002. His principal research interests are in twentieth century British economic and political history.

Among his publications are *British Rearmament and the Treasury, 1932-9* (1979), *British Economic and Social Policy: Lloyd George to Margaret Thatcher* (1985; 2nd edition 1991), *Keynes, the Treasury and British Economic Policy* (1988), *The Treasury and British Public Policy, 1906-1959* (2000), and his latest book, *Arms, Economics and British Strategy: From Dreadnoughts to Hydrogen Bombs* (Cambridge University Press, 2007).
